The students who have got admission into the six-year integrated programme of RGUKT- R K Valley Campus are informed to report to RGUKT-RK Valley Campus (located at Idupulapaya, Vempalli (M), YSR Kadapa-516330) during 18th or 19th of December 2021.

Similarly, the students who have got admission into the six-year integrated programme of RGUKT- Ongole Campus are informed to report to RGUKT-RK Valley Campus (located at Idupulapaya, Vempalli (M), YSR Kadapa-516330) during 18th or 19th of December 2021. Pre-University Course Classwork of RGUKT-Ongole Campus will be held at RGUKT-RK Valley Campus.

The Classwork for both RK Valley and Ongole Students will commence from 20th December, 2021. Students are informed to plan your travel accordingly.

Students who have not submitted original certificate(s) at the time of admission are informed to submit the same without fail at time of reporting. Further, it is informed to bring Stamp Size photos of Parents/Guardians and Students for issuing Parent ID card and Student ID card.

## General Guidelines to the candidates while reporting to the campuses:

- 1. You are advised to come with only one parent/guardian
- 2. You are advised to submit COVID negative report. In case students do not submit the COVID report, the Institute will conduct the COVID test by collecting Rs.250/- from each candidate.
- 3. You are advised to bring your own bucket, mug, lock with key, water bottle and other important items as per your requirement.
- 4. Use of electric heaters, electric stoves, and iron boxes etc. is completely prohibited in the hostel rooms.
- 5. University is not responsible for your personal belongings such as mobile phones, money and other valuable items that you bring.
- 6. Mobile phones are not permitted into the class rooms and library.
- 7. Students should maintain proper discipline in the class rooms, hostel blocks and at messes during dining. Any indiscipline observed will attract punishment from the institute authorities as per existing guidelines of both state level and national level authorities.
- 8. Students need to contact HoD/PUC Coordinator for any academic relating issues, and need to contract care taker/warden/Dean Student welfare for any other advice.

#### COVID related Guidelines:

In view of the COVID pandemic situation, all students shall follow the following guidelines related to COVID strictly.

#### DO's

- Wearing face mask/cover is compulsory in Academic blocks and in all public places
- All persons in charge of work places shall ensure social distancing.
- Social distancing (2 Gaz ki doori) at work places shall be ensured through adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc.
- Social distancing (2 Gaz ki doori) at residential places shall be ensured across all common places such as Grocery/Vegetables point or any other place as informed by the respective campuses.
- Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer preferably with touch free mechanism will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas. In addition, sufficient quantities of hand wash and sanitizer shall be made available in all the work places.
- Frequent sanitization of entire work place, common facilities and all points which come into human contact eg. Door handles, lift buttons etc., shall be ensured.

### Don'ts

- All social/ political/sports/entertainment/cultural/religious functions and other mass gatherings.
- Religious congregations.
- No public place shall allow large gathering
- Spitting in public places shall be punishable with fine as prescribed by the State/ UT local authorities.
- Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. is not allowed in the campus. No unchecked influx of people.
- Large gatherings/meetings are prohibited until further orders.
